

You will be provided a ticket to turn in the night of the meal so that we know that you have paid.

If you don't sign up for the meal ahead of time, the charge will be \$25.00 the night of the dinner!!!!

CELL SERVICE INFORMATION

Cell service is very limited at this facility. In the past the show manager (Donna Phillips) has had service. If there is an emergency feel free to come to her and also give her number to your families to contact in an emergency. The show manager also has a hot spot in the office if you have a need for it. This show is accredited and conducted under the 2025 rules and regulations of the American Shetland Pony Club (ASPC/AMHR). All horses must be registered with ASPC/AMHR. All horses must be measured by the AMHR Steward or present a measurement slip documenting measurement by an official AMHR steward within the last 60 days or a permanent card that has been validated in the year 2025. Youth and /or amateur numbers must be provided. Valid AMHR registration, current Coggins (within 1 year), and health certificate within 30 days on out-of-state horses must be provided. Foals six months and younger do not require a Coggins when traveling with the mare. In-State horses must present current Coggins (within 1 year).

PREMIUMS: Ribbons will be awarded for first through sixth place in each class, Grand/Reserve Champions and Champion/Reserve horses.

GENERAL RULES

Evidence of any inhumane treatment to a horse in or out of the show ring will result in disqualification of that horse and that exhibitor for the balance of the show, as well as all of that horse's and exhibitor's points, ribbons, trophies, plus all entry, stall, and office fees being forfeited.

DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES AND CONTROLLED BY OWNER

Trash: Trash cans are available on the grounds and near the arena. Please dispose of your trash properly.

Members of NEMHS, exhibitors, representatives and spectators agree to conduct themselves professionally and utilize good sportsmanship at all times. Violators are subject to removal from the grounds.

Dress Code: Absolutely no torn jeans, sweat pants, shorts, t-shirts, tank tops or open toed shoes are allowed in the ring. This includes all ring personnel. Proper show attire will be worn by exhibitors in the ring at all times, including Championship and Grand classes. Please refer to your rulebook, especially for Showmanship classes.

Judge and Show Management Evaluations: Evaluation forms will be available in the show office to be completed on a voluntary basis.

Return Check Fee: There will be a \$35.00 charge for any returned check by NEMHS.

Refunds: No refunds will be given on any office fees or stall fees. Refunds will only be given on receipt of veterinary certificate stating the reason the horse was unable to show. Substitutions will be accepted without penalty. This show will run rain or shine. There is an indoor arena.

ENTRIES

Please pre-enter if possible. Entries postmarked or emailed after the deadline are subject to an additional fee. Pre-entries must be accompanied by payment. Refunds will be made with a veterinarian's certificate or a physician's letter. Please see refunds above.

Provided you have pre-entered, classes may be added on the day of the show without penalty.

Please take care to fill out the entry form completely and carefully, and include your signature and amateur/youth numbers where indicated.

A copy of both sides of your horses' AMHR/ASPC registration papers must accompany the entry form and be presented at measuring.

Youth and Amateur exhibitors must hold current AMHR Youth or Amateur cards, or may apply with the show steward the day of the show. Please include your youth and amateur numbers on the entry form, and enclose a copy of your current youth and amateur cards with your entry form. Amateurs must also sign the entry form where indicated. AMHR youth is an individual that has not attained eighteen years of age as of December 1st of the current competition year.

Gelding Status: It must be reflected on the registration papers in order for the horse to be shown in any AMHR classes.

Leased Horses: They must be on record with ASPC/AMHR. Include a copy of the lease authorization form, and indicate on your entry that the horse is leased.

Driving Horses: All driving horses are to be driven with a bit. NEMHS request that all Youth drivers wear an ASTM approved helmet. Helmets are required in youth roadster classes.

Stalls: No more than 2 horses per stall. Stallions over 2 years must be stalled separately. Pre-ordered shavings will be available for pick up when you arrive at the facility. You may bring your own shavings. Stall waste is to be dumped in designated areas only. Contact the show manager to make stall arrangements. Stalls are a minimum of 10' x 10'. **Stalls will be available after 12 noon on Thursday. Absolutely no early arrivals.**

PA System: This is a courtesy provided by the facility. If it does not function, show management will work with the facility to ensure this service, but it is not guaranteed. We will be using a two-minute gate call. Please check in with the gate manager when arriving at the ring so that the show can continue at a steady pace. It is each exhibitor's responsibility to be at the gate on time. Should a tack change be required please request this at the gate at least five classes ahead of the needed time.

Concession Stand: There will be a concession stand available on the grounds for breakfast, lunch and dinner. There will also be a meal served on Saturday evening.

Wine and Cheese night: There will be a wine and cheese event Friday evening at the conclusion of the day's classes. For the kids there will be a Movie Under The Stars event.

COOL: Special needs individuals are always welcome to participate in all AMHR shows. If special arrangements are needed please try to contact the Show Manager ahead of time, if possible.

CAMPING: There are sites available with water and electric. There is also dry camping available (no hookups). Sites available on a first com-first serve basis. There are no sewer hookups. There is a dump station at the facility.

Discounted fees: Discounted fees are for members of the **New England Miniature Horse Society**.

COGGINS/HEALTH PAPERS

Coggins and Health papers are required at the facility. Please follow current CT state requirements for coggins and health papers. Please note that the requirements for out-of-state horses and in state horses may vary. Consult with your veterinarian, and be sure to travel with the documents required by the states you are traveling through and showing in. Please have your health forms available at time of measuring.

MEASURING

Measuring starts two hours before show time, and by special request, whenever possible throughout the day. Measuring will also be available Thursday evening 4:00pm-7:00pm. Show start time will be 9:00am Friday, 8:00am Saturday and Sunday. Measuring will be conducted by the AMHR Show Steward. At the time of measurement, please have available your registration papers and a current negative Coggins for each horse to be shown. All horses must be measured, present a valid 60 day pink slip or present a validated permanent card before entering their first class.

Silent Auction: The club will be having a silent auction during the weekend. Plan to bid and feel free to bring something to donate. Items can be either horse or non-horse related.

Photographer: Elizabeth K. Photography will be on site taking pictures in the ring and will be available during non-show times to do personal photo shoots outside. Lots of beautiful places at this facility for pictures
