This show is accredited and conducted under the 2025 rules and regulations of the American Shetland Pony Club (ASPC/AMHR). All horses must be registered with ASPC/AMHR. All horses must be measured by the AMHR Steward or present a measurement slip documenting measurement by an official AMHR steward within the last 60 days or a permanent card that has been validated in the year 2025. Youth and /or amateur numbers must be provided. Valid AMHR/ASPC registration must be provided.

<u>PREMIUMS:</u> Ribbons will be awarded for first through sixth place in each class, Grand/Reserve Champions and Champion/Reserve horses.

Members of NEMHS, exhibitors, representatives and spectators agree to conduct themselves professionally and utilize good sportsmanship at all times. Violators are subject to removal from the grounds.

GENERAL RULES

Evidence of any inhumane treatment to a horse in or out of the show ring will result in disqualification of that horse and that exhibitor for the balance of the show, as well as all of that horse's and exhibitor's points, ribbons, trophies, plus all entry, stall, and office fees being forfeited.

Dogs must be on a leash and under control of owner at all times.

<u>Trash</u>: Trash cans are available on the grounds and near the arena. Please dispose of your trash properly.

<u>Dress Code</u>: Absolutely no torn jeans, sweat pants, shorts, t-shirts, tank tops or open toed shoes are allowed in the ring. This includes all ring personnel. Proper show attire will be worn by exhibitors in the ring at all times, including Championship and Grand classes. Please refer to your rulebook, especially for Showmanship classes.

<u>Judge, Steward, Show and Show Management Evaluations</u>: Evaluation forms will be available in the show office to be completed on a voluntary basis.

Return Check Fee: There will be a \$35.00 charge for any returned check by NEMHS.

<u>Refunds:</u> No refunds will be given on any office fees or stall fees. Refunds will only be given on receipt of veterinary certificate stating the reason the horse was unable to show. Substitutions will be accepted without penalty. This show will run rain or shine. There is an indoor arena.

ENTRIES

Please pre-enter if possible. Entries postmarked or emailed after the deadline are subject to an additional fee. Pre-entries must be accompanied by payment. Refunds will be made with a veterinarian's certificate or a physicians' letter. Please see refunds above.

Provided you have pre-entered, classes may be added on the day of the show without penalty.

Please take care to fill out the entry form completely and carefully, and include your signature and amateur/youth numbers where indicated.

A copy of both sides of your horses' AMHR/ASPC registration papers must accompany the entry form and be presented at measuring.

Youth and Amateur exhibitors must hold current AMHR Youth or Amateur cards, or may apply with the show steward the day of the show for an additional fee for Amateur card. Please include your youth and amateur numbers on the entry form, and enclose a copy of your current youth and amateur cards with your entry form. Amateurs must also sign the entry form where indicated. AMHR youth is an individual that has not attained eighteen years of age as of December 1st of the current competition year.

<u>Gelding Status:</u> It must be reflected on the registration papers in order for the horse to be shown in any AMHR classes.

<u>Leased Horses</u>: They must be on record with ASPC/AMHR. Include a copy of the lease authorization form, and indicate on your entry that the horse is leased.

<u>Driving Horses:</u> All driving horses are to be driven with a bit. NEMHS request that all Youth drivers wear an ASTM approved helmet. Helmets are required in youth roadster classes.

<u>Stalls:</u> No more than 2 horses per stall. Stallions over 2 years must be stalled separately. You must bring your own shavings. Stall waste is to be dumped in designated areas only. Contact the show manager to make stall arrangements. Stalls are a minimum of $10' \times 10$

<u>PA System</u>: This is a courtesy provided by the facility. If it does not function, show management will work with the facility to ensure this service, but it is not guaranteed. We will be using a two-minute gate call. Please check in with the gate manager when arriving at the ring so that the show can continue at a steady pace. It is each exhibitor's responsibility to be at the gate on time. Should a tack change be required please request this at the gate at least five classes ahead of the needed time.

COOL: Special needs individuals are always welcome to participate in all AMHR shows. If special arrangements are needed please try to contact the Show Manager ahead of time, if possible.

<u>CAMPING:</u> There are sites available with water, electric and sewer. Also, some with electric and water. There are also dry camping sites available (no hookups). Sites available on a first com-first serve basis.

Discounted class fees: Discounted fees are for members of the New England Miniature Horse Society.

COGGINS/HEALTH PAPERS

Coggins and Health papers are required at the facility. Please follow current NY state requirements for Coggins and health papers. Please note that the requirements for out-of-state horses and in-state horses may vary. Consult with your veterinarian, and be sure to travel with the documents required by the states you are traveling through and showing in. Please have your health forms available for inspection if asked for them.

MEASURING

Measuring starts two hours before show time on Saturday, and by special request, whenever possible throughout the day. Show start time will be 9:00am Saturday and 8:00am Sunday. Measuring will be conducted by the AMHR Show Steward. At the time of measurement, please have available your registration papers and a current negative Coggins for each horse to be shown. All horses must be measured, present a valid 60 day pink slip or present a validated permanent card before entering their first class.

DIRECTIONS FROM NEW YORK AREA TO COBLESKILL, NY

Take New York Thruway North to exit 25A, which is I-88
Take I-88 to exit 22 (the first Cobleskill exit)
Turn left after the ramp and turn right onto County Road 1 (Mineral Springs Road)
Turn right onto Grand Street and Fairgrounds is on the right.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE WEST TO COBLESKILL, NY

Take New York Thruway East to the Canajoharie exit and then get on Route 10. Follow it South, turn right on to North Grand Street and it will bring you directly into the village of Cobleskill.

At the red light in the center of the village go straight across Main Street to South Grand Street and Fairgrounds is on the left after you go under the railroad underpass.

DIRECTIONS FROM BINGHAMTON, NY/PENNSYLVANIA TO COBLESKILL, NY

Follow I-88 East to exit 21 (it is also marked for SUNY Cobleskill). Bear to the left to Route 7. Turn right and follow Route 7 to County Route 1 (Mineral Springs Road) Go to Grand Street. Turn left and the Fairgrounds is on the right.
